Sustainable Commute Options

- Ride WeGo Public Transit local and regional buses, paratransit vans (for eligible riders) and the WeGo Star commuter trains free of charge, anytime WeGo service is running, with your [physical Commodore Card](#). WeGo buses run every 10-20 minutes during peak times on West End and 21st avenues with multiple stops convenient to campus. Learn more at vu.edu/bus.
- [Sustainable commutes](#) such as walking, biking, bus, train, carpool and vanpool can **earn monetary bonuses** for those enrolled in daily parking who log weekday commutes.

[Daily Parking Program](#)

- Pay to park only on days you drive and park your vehicle on campus. [View lot locations](#).
- [Applications](#) received by Monday afternoon will be processed by Wednesday afternoon.
- [Parking charges](#) and sustainable commute bonuses are deducted and credited in the payroll cycle after charges are accrued and credited.

- Hourly paid parking is available in select parking lots and garages across campus with the [ParkMobile](#) app.
- These [convenient spaces](#) are an option for individuals visiting campus or needing short-term parking and are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

[Chestnut Lot](#) free parking is available with the VUMC shuttle to campus (call 615-936-1215 to confirm shuttle use).

[Annual Parking Permit](#)

- Temporary 1-month new employee parking permits are available in person at the VUPS Parking Services* office with a debit, credit card or check. *This is a one-time purchase; no extensions will be granted.*
- Annual permits allow you to park in any nonreserved parking space in annual permit lots. Parking is first come, first served on campus. [View lot locations](#).
