## **Measurements for Sizing a Lab Coat**

## **How to Size Women's Lab Coats**

Women's lab coats typically have a different cut than do men's coats. Women buyers should use their dress size to determine their coat size. If you measure yourself, ensure to wrap the tape measure relatively loosely under your armpits, over the shoulder blades, and across the front of your chest.

### **How to Size Men's Lab Coats**

Men should generally use suit jacket measurements to size their lab coats. Look for your size on the inside of a jacket or suit you already own, or you can measure the circumference of your chest. Place the tape under the armpits and wrap it around the shoulder blades in back to account for the widest part of your torso. Height: Students taller than 6-feet may want to opt for a "long" or tall lab coat. The tall designation adds several inches to the length of the sleeves to accommodate longer arms.
